

Troop 200 Uniform Guidelines

General Uniform Guidelines

The complete official Troop 200 "Class A" uniform includes:

- Official BSA long-sleeved or short-sleeved shirt (shirt tails must be tucked into pants). The shirt should have the following patches:
 - Council patch
 - Troop numbers
 - Patrol patch
- Official BSA pants or shorts
- Official BSA belt and buckle
- Official BSA green socks, closed toe shoes or boots
- Troop 200 neckerchief with a Scout theme slide. The neckerchief should be neatly rolled and worn under the shirt collar.

The troop activity uniform, often called the "Class B uniform", includes:

- Red Troop 200 Activity Shirt or Scout themed T-shirt (e.g., Scout summer camp T-shirt), with shirt tails tucked into pants
- Official BSA green shorts or long pants
- Official BSA web belt or Scout theme leather belt and buckle set (such as Philmont or Jamboree belt and buckle)
- Official BSA green socks worn with closed toe shoes or boots.

Official BSA Items purchased by the Scout:

- Troop 200 Hat (ball cap style)
- "Class A" Shirt (tan with shoulder loops)
- "Class B" Red Troop Activity Shirt
- Mt Diablo Silverado "council strip"
- World Scouting Crest
- Scout Belt
- BSA Pants/Shorts (green)
- BSA Socks (green)
- Merit Badge Sash (green)
